Enterprise vs Concurrent Access

- Primary difference between concurrent access and DCP Enterprise is the guaranteed access.
- With concurrent access, the users who the code is shared with can login to Digital Codes and enter the concurrent code. If all licenses are in use, they do not gain access to the contents and features of the subscription until one of the licenses frees up from another user signing out.






