- 3) Such classes are necessary for those of you who are Certified Floodplain Managers (CFM) to maintain your certification; and
- 4) For any of you who are interested in becoming a CFM, these classes will provide an excellent foundation!

FEMA, DWR and the County of Placer are all very supportive of bringing more education to local floodplain managers, and want to encourage more CFMs locally. These classes will be held free to you, and we hope to set up additional classes in the future if we have a good response to these.
